

STUDENT RIGHT-TO-KNOW GRADUATION RATE

In compliance with the Student Right-to-Know Act, Douglas Education Center must calculate completion/graduation rate using the specified formula.

To calculate the completion rate, the school identifies a cohort of students each year and reviews the performance of that cohort over time, not to exceed one and a half times the normal program length.

Douglas Education Center uses a fall cohort, that is, students who started in the fall semester or the immediately preceding summer semester, and are still enrolled as of October 15th. Only first-time, full-time certificate- or degree-seeking students are included in the calculation.

The following formula is used to calculate the Student Right-to-Know completion rate:

**Number of students in the cohort who completed their
program within 150% of normal time for completion**

Number of students in the cohort (minus permitted exclusions)

Douglas Education Center's Student Right-to-Know completion rate is based on the fall 2009 cohort. Disclosure of the Student Right-to-Know rate for the Fall 2009 Cohort is required from July 1, 2012 through June 30, 2013.

Douglas Education Center's Student Right-to-Know completion rate for the Fall 2009 Cohort is 94% (218 completers/231 students in cohort).
