

The "Tom Savini Scholarship" for Special Make-Up Effects Students - \$5,000

There is one scholarship offered prior to each Fall semester only. Only <u>NEW</u> students enrolled in Tom Savini's Special Make-Up Effects Program at Douglas Education Center (DEC) and who have submitted the requested material will be considered for the scholarship. Tom Savini and staff will choose the recipient. The winner will be notified via mail within one month of the application deadline.

PLEASE SUBMIT THE FOLLOWING:

- 1. A 250-500 word typed essay on why you want to go into the field of special effects, and what your plans are after graduation; and
- 2. A portfolio of your work. It may be a hard copy (portfolio, book, prints) or sent on a thumbdrive, CD or DVD. Acceptable formats are; JPG, PNG, PDF Documents, or Powerpoint.

All portfolio submissions must be solely the work of the individual applying for the scholarship. It should include high-quality photos of one or more of the following: make-ups (both fashion and/or creature), sculptures, masks, paintings, or any other finished pieces. You will be judged on creativity, design, application, and completeness of work. Materials submitted will not be returned, but can be picked up in the Marketing Office at Douglas Education Center before December 1st, 2019.
